### **MVC Licensing Center in Camden Closed Until November 16**

TRENTON – The New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission has announced that, effective immediately, the Camden Licensing Center is closed due to an employee testing positive for COVID-19. The Camden Licensing Center will reopen Monday, November 16.

The employee who tested positive was last in the Camden Center on Saturday, October 31.

As announced earlier today, due to staff quarantines, the Wayne and South Plainfield Licensing Centers will be appointment-only until Monday, November 23. No walk-ins will be allowed at either location.

The Wayne and South Plainfield Centers both will be closed on Saturday, November 14, and Saturday, November 21.

The Freehold Licensing Center also will be on an appointment-only basis (no walk-ins allowed) on Saturday, November 14.

In addition, the following MVC Centers remain closed due to an employee testing positive for COVID-19, and will reopen on the listed dates:

- **Paterson Regional/Licensing Center** – reopens Saturday, November 14
- **Cherry Hill Vehicle Center** – reopens Monday, November 16
- **Runnemede Vehicle Center** – reopens Thursday, November 19
- **Trenton Regional/Vehicle Center** – reopens Friday, November 20
- **Eatontown Regional/Licensing Center** – reopens Friday, November 20
- **Bayonne Licensing Center** – reopens Tuesday, November 24

The Oakland Licensing Center will be reopening tomorrow, November 13, and fully operational after quarantine closing and full COVID-19 cleaning.
